Paris Declaration Principles:

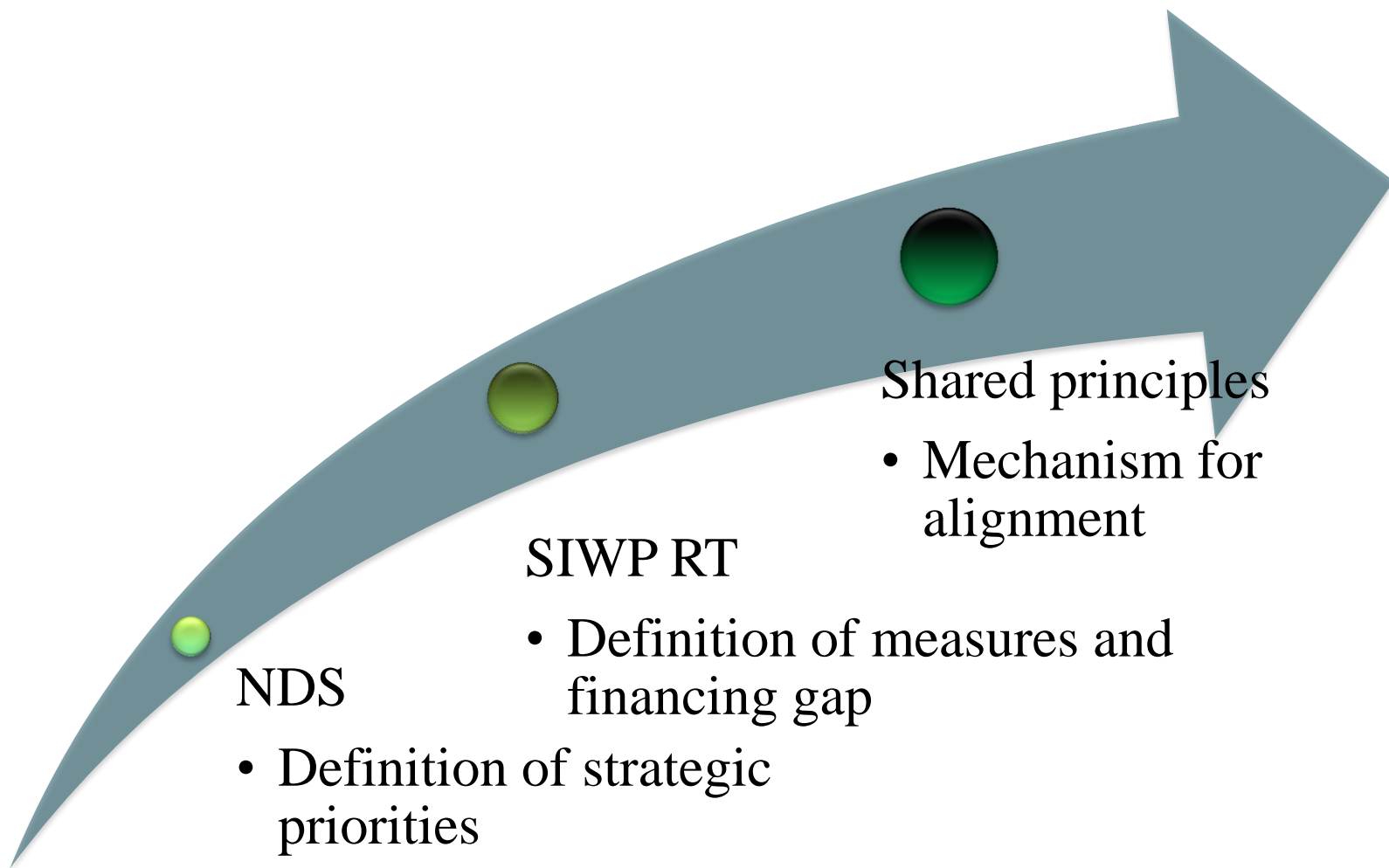
- Ownership

Implementation of JCPS goals

- Development Partners provided significant support for implementation of NDS and PRS;
- More efficient and targeted aid coordination;
- Activities have been implemented to achieve set development goals, including monitoring of the Paris Declaration on Aid Effectiveness indicators;



Ownership and Alignment

Steps to develop institutional capacity of national aid coordination:

- Adoption of Guidelines for aid mobilization, use, coordination and monitoring;
- SCISPM mandate is strengthened and structure improved. SCISPM is the Central Authorized Government body, responsible for aid coordination;
- Formalization of national coordination procedure;
- Ensuring better “labour division” and improving interagency interaction of national stakeholders;



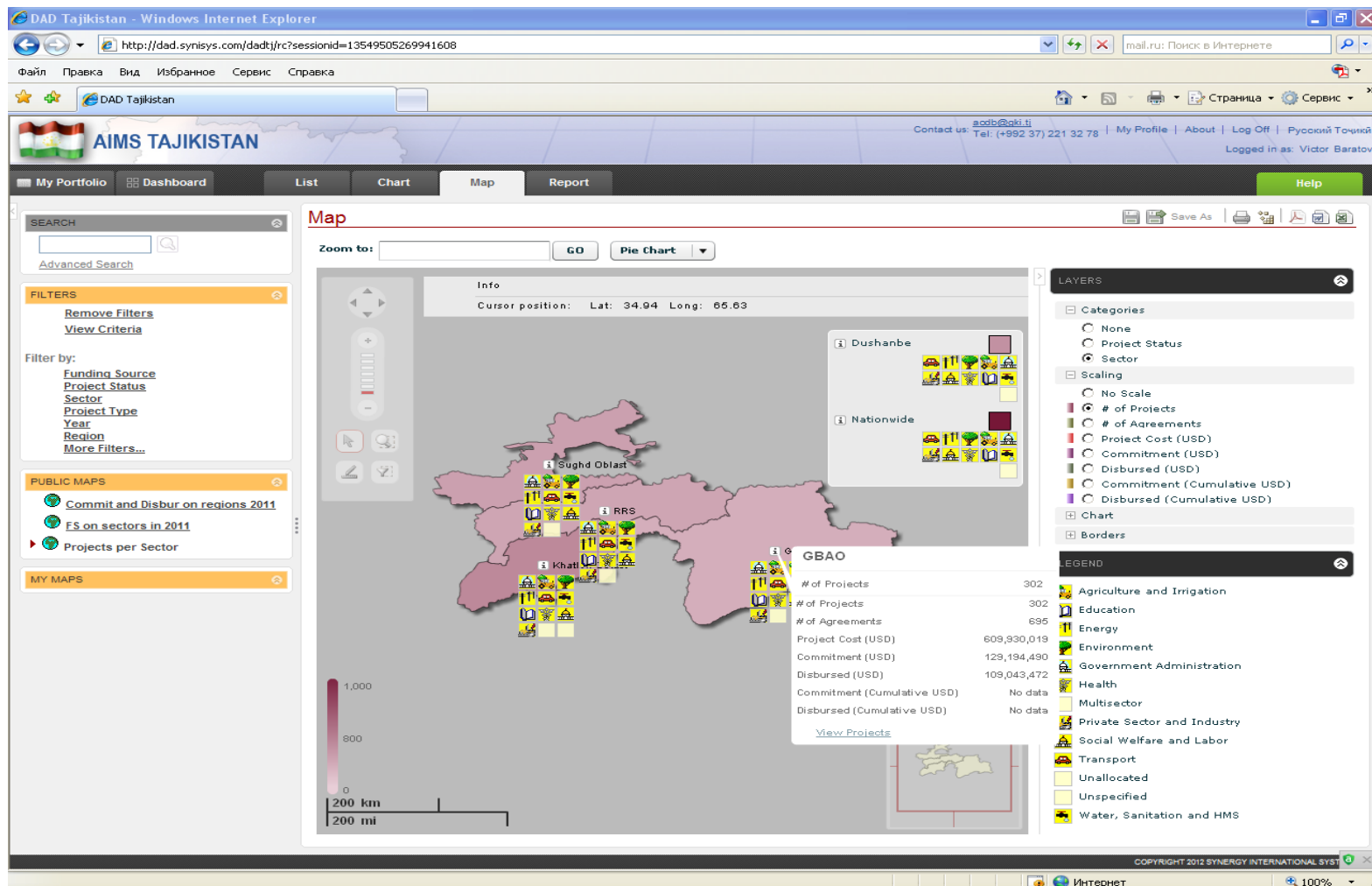
Transparency and Accountability

Main tools of Transparency and Accountability:

- Foreign Aid Database, containing information on aid flows since 2002;
- Annual updating of information on aid projects and agreements;
- Publication of information-analytical Guides Development Partner Profiles, Foreign Aid Report, preparation of several reports and information upon the request of the users;
- Aid coordination website, it is functional and informative, ensuring more than 1100 visits per month;
- Tajikistan web-page on Busan Forum Official website.

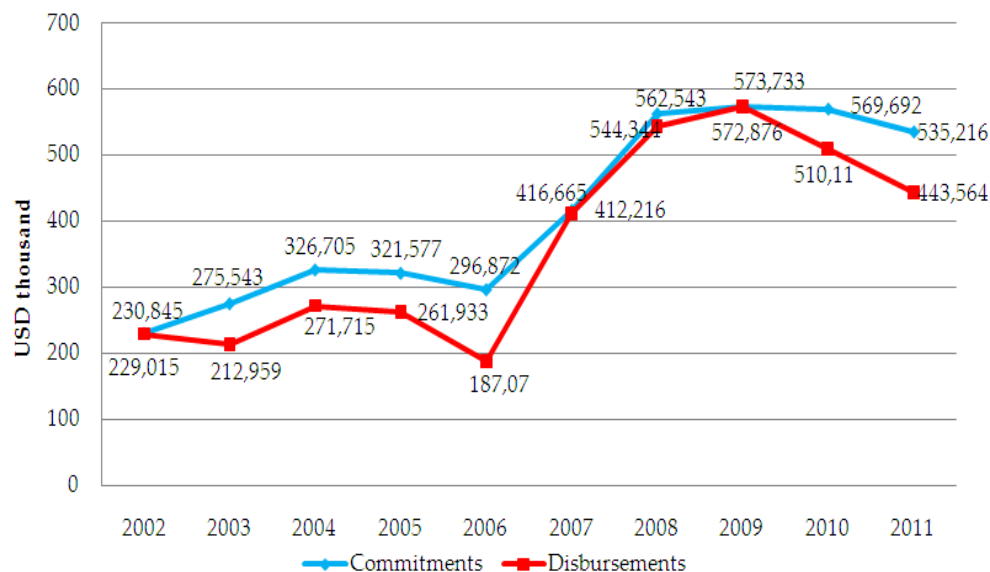
Information-analytical resources on Aid coordination





Foreign Aid Trends

- Upward trend during 10 years;
- Foreign aid reached 26 percents of the Government budget and 7 percents of the GDP;
- Steep increase from 2007 linked to enhanced number of partners.



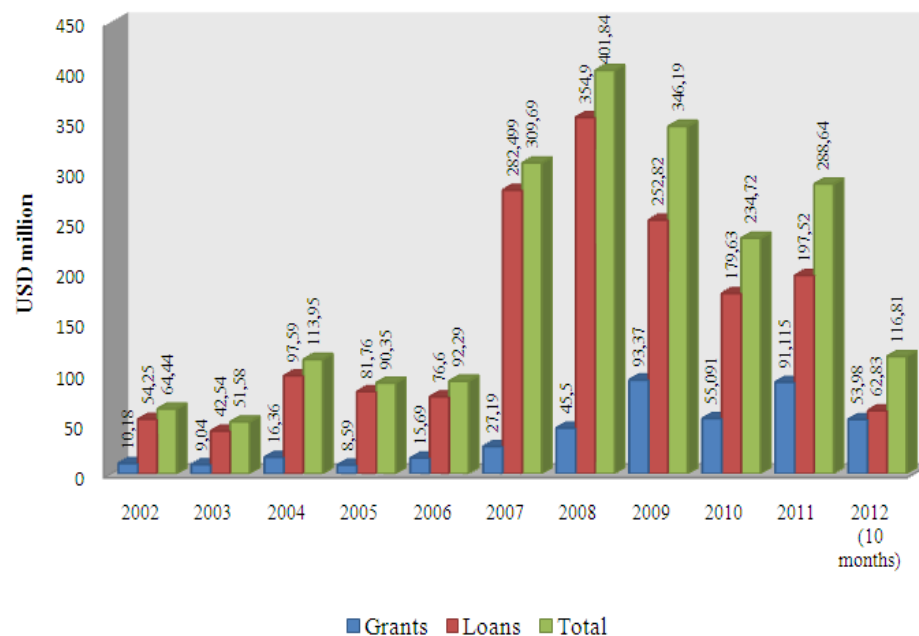


Joint Investment Projects

- Currently 57 joint investment projects are being implemented for the total amount of USD 1 bln. 913 mln. (as of 01.11.2012)
- The total of USD 1 bln. 169 mln. has been disbursed since the beginning of ongoing projects implementation or 61 percent (as of 01.11.2012)



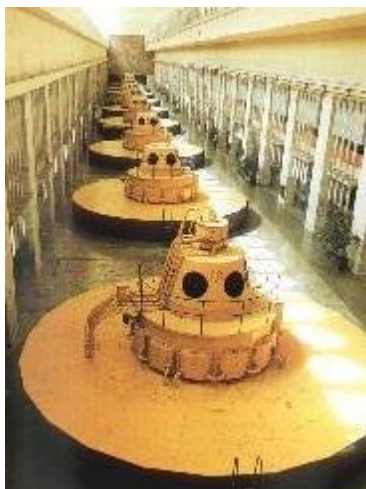

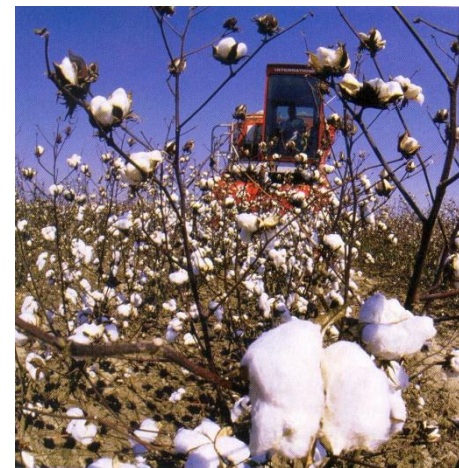
Projects in the **Transport Sector:**

- Construction of Shagon-Zigar road;
- Improvement of Dushanbe – Kulma road, Dushanbe-Danghara



Projects in the **Energy Sector:**

- Replacement of open distributive machine (ODM) 220 kw of Nurek HES;
- Replacement of open distributive machine (ODM) 500 kw of Nurek HES;
- Regional power transmission project 0213 TAJ (SF).



Projects in the **Agriculture Sector:**

- Emergency Food Security and
- Seed Import;
- Agriculture Rehabilitation;
- Dangara Valley Irrigation;
- Irrigation Rehabilitation;
- Cotton Sector Recovery;
- Ferghana Valley Water Resources Management.



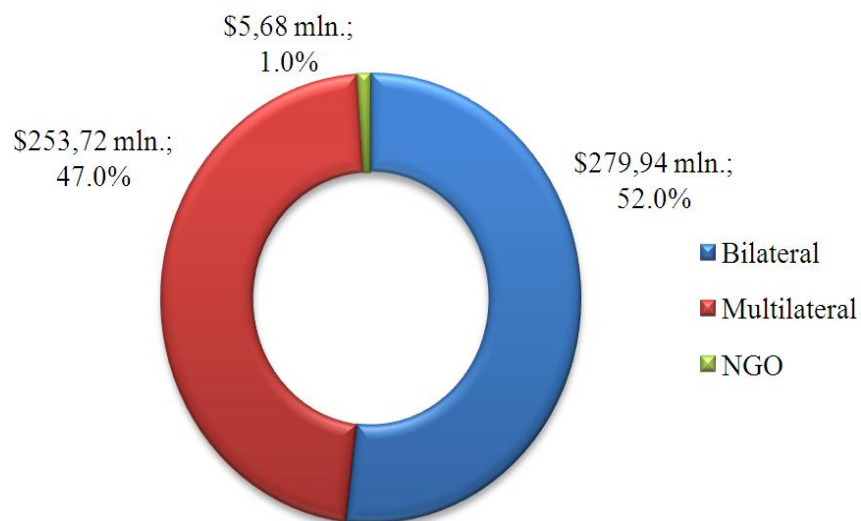
Support of the PRS

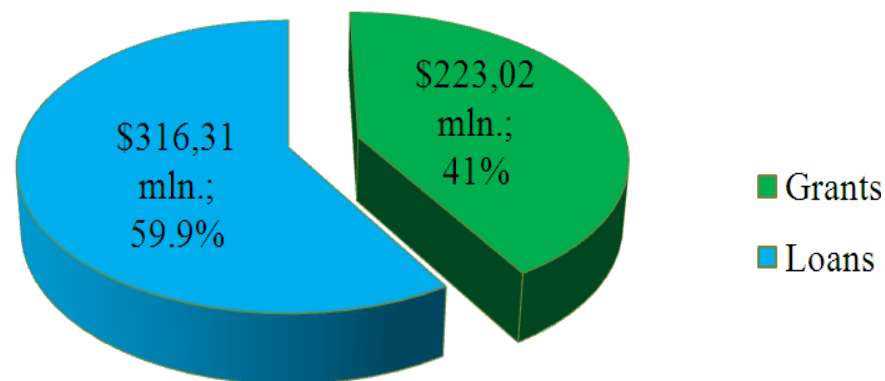
