KEY OPPORTUNITIES IN THE SECTOR FOR DCC TO KNOW

- Expand the role of the Food Security Council, with a mandate to provide effective governance for a multi-sectorial approach to food security and nutrition, and with adequate links to the SUN multi-sectorial platform
- Continue to support nutrition-sensitive social safety nets
- Develop contingency plans to provide timely and coordinated responses to food security and nutrition crises due to economic shocks, agricultural failure or natural disasters
- Promote understanding of good nutrition and household hygiene

KEY CHALLENGES IN THE SECTOR

- · Key national strategies and policies are not effectively implemented
- Agricultural and food systems vulnerable to shocks and stressors from climate change and market fluctuations
- The nutrition sector is seriously underfunded, and no key nutrition-related national plans
- Fragmented coordination between development partners, their projects and government actors.
- Aggressive marketing of commercial milk formula, junk food, and mislabeling of foods leading to consumer nutrition and health vulnerability
