1. Measures to protect the populations and territories:

In the winter period the heavy snowfalls caused damage to the different sectors of economy. As a of avalanches, unfortunately, people result the were Because of the strong and heavy rainfall during the spring, the landslide and mudflow occurred in 40 districts of the republic. Only in April-May months 33 people were killed in the country. A damage was caused to the people and economy of According to the preliminary calculations and reports from the Commission of Emergency Situations for 2010 the damage to the population and economy of the republic estimated over 518,796.700Somoni.

During the period of the last year, the damage was amounted in 100, 200.767 Somoni.

During the last year as a result of 186 disasters 45 citizens of the republic were died.

As a result of natural disasters totally 4425 houses were destroyed and damaged, the amount of damage estimated in 74965.8 thousand Somoni, including 646 fully destroyed houses.

The documents about provision of one-time humanitarian assistance were prepared and submitted to the Government of Tajikistan by the specialists from the Department of Protection of Population and Territories. According to this the State Commission for Emergency Situation based on the order #19/1-2-0.2 from February 17th, 2010 allocated **196,459 Somoni** to the people affected from the earthquake in Vanj Ditsirct of GBAO and based on the order # 19/1-2-9 from May 20th, 2010 **894,400 Somoni** was allocated to the people affected from the mudflow occurred in Khatlon region.

Also, based on the Order # 19/1-2-26 dated on October 5, 2010 the State Commission allocated **343 thousand Somoni** to the affected people in Vanj, Jomi, Aini and Gonchi of Sughd province. Based on the order of the State Commission from November 12, 2010 # 19-1-233 **229,650 Somoni** was allocated to the affected areas of Roshtqala, Rushon, Murgob, Shugnon, Darvoz, Ishkoshim and Khorog town of GBAO, cities of Istravshan and Pandzhakent of Sughd Province and Rudaki and Hissor regions.

Only in 2010, the State Commission for Emergency Situations allocated 1.663,46 somoni to the people affected from the natural disaster and 46 hundred somoni to the families who lost their family members a onetime humanitarian assistance.
