DRR and Development Integration

- Disasters damage developmental efforts
- Development needs to be resilient: the ability to resist/recover from disasters
- Failing resilience, development fails

- Integrate risk reduction into development projects and activities
- Already policy UNDP, WB, DFID, others
- Makes sense if development can reduce the number of disasters, then we will suffer less and advance faster
- But how to get development people to think disaster?
