Tajikistan Weekly Market Situation Update

Highlights

- Staple food commodities were available in all monitored markets during the reporting week.
- Price increases were observed for wheat flour (4-9 percent), cotton oil (2-9 percent), carrots (18-36 percent) and onions (6-11 percent) in several markets, and potatos (20-46 percent) in all • monitored markets during the reporting week compared to the previous week. Prices continued to fluctuate in the five monitored markets during the week and remained high against monthly averages of March 2020 and March 2019.
- In Gharm market, retailers reported an increase of purchases on credit by clients, which comprised 15-20 percent from the total weekly purchases.

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



The monitoring is conducted twice a week in four central markets including Khorog, Khujand, Bokhtar, Gharm as well as Dushanbe, and focuses on the main commodities that are consumed by the average population of the country.
