# **Tajikistan Weekly Market Situation Update, #12**

Week of 01 – 05 JUNE 2020

#### **Highlights**

- Staple food commodities were available, and no major changes took place in most monitored markets during the reporting week. The current week's market monitoring observations are as follows:
  - 1.Central markets are operating at 30-40 percent capacity to provide access to staple food for the population
  - 2.Prices in several monitored markets increased against previous week for salt (20-33 percent) and bread (9-20 percent).
  - 3. Fewer people were observed in the markets in Gharm and Khorog, as markets are running on half capacity. In contrast, more people have been visiting the Khujand market compared to previous weeks.
  - 4.Due to harvesting season and abundant supply of agricultural products, farmers are supplying more fruits, melons and other vegetables to the market.
  - 5. The protective measures against COVID-19, such as wearing masks and keeping social distance, is being enforced through constant monitoring and communication by the market and state authorities.
- Compared to May 2019, prices remain high though this week's prices were stable or slightly lower against monthly averages of May 2020.

# Wheat flour (first grade)

Markets in **Khujand** and **Bokhtar** reported a **decrease** in prices of wheat flour **by 3 percent** while in the remaining markets prices remained stable compared to previous week.

Comparing the current reporting week to the monthly average of May 2020, prices for wheat flour **decreased** in **most monitored markets**, ranging from **1-5 percent**. Meanwhile, prices **increased** by **3 percent** in **Khujand**.

#### Rice

Rice prices increased in **Khujand Bokhtar** and **Gharm** markets, ranging from **2-27 percent** while prices **decreased** in **Khorog** by **8 percent**.

Compared to the May 2020 monthly average, prices for rice increased in **Gharm, Bokhtar and Dushanbe** markets ranging from **3.4-44 percent** and it decreased in **Khujand and Khorog** in the range of **5.4-20 percent.** 

### **Potatoes**

Markets in **Khorog, Gharm and Khujand** reported a **decrease** in prices for potatoes by the range of **8-31 percent** compared to the previous week, while in **Bokhtar** its market prices **increased by 4.3 percent**.

Compared against monthly average of May 2020, **most monitored markets** reported a **decrease** in prices of potatoes ranging from **6.3-46 percent.** Prices in **Bokhtar** market **increased** by **20 percent.** 

## Onion

Onion prices remained stable in **Gharm** while an **increase** in prices was observed in **Khorog and Bokhtar** markets in the range of **11-20 percent**. Prices for this commodity **decreased** by a range of **6.3 -20 percent** in **Khujand**, **Murghab** and **Dushanbe**.

Compared to the monthly average of May 2020, prices for onions **decreased** in **most markets** in the range of **1-31.4 percent**, while in **Bokhtar** market its prices increased by **46 percent**.

# **Vegetable & Cotton Oil**

Compared to previous week, prices for vegetable oil decreased in Bokhtar by 11 percent and in Murghab and Gharm in the range of 1-4 percent for both commodities. Other markets prices remained stable.

Compared with the monthly average of May 2020, prices **increased** in **Khujand** market by **6.1 percent** for cotton oil and in **Dushanbe** market by **4 percent** for vegetable oil. Meanwhile prices in the rest of the markets for both commodities **decreased** by a range of **2.3 – 14 percent**.

# Milk & Eggs

Prices for milk and eggs decreased in most monitored markets in the range of **10-14.3 percent**, while in Khorog, prices for milk increased by **20 percent** compared to the previous week.

Compared to the May 2020 monthly average, prices for both commodities **decreased** in the range of **2.2–23 percent** in **most monitored markets**, while in **Khorog** market prices increased for milk by **4.3 percent**.

#### **Meat Beef & Mutton**


Compared to previous week, prices for both mutton and beef were **stable in Gharm and Dushanbe**. Increase in prices was reported for **mutton** in **Bokhtar** and **Khujand** markets by **1–4.3 percent** while prices for beef **decreased in Bokhtar and Murgab** markets by **1 percent**. In Khorog market, prices for both commodities **decreased** by **1 percent**.

Compared against May 2020 monthly averages, prices increased for mutton in Khujand, Bokhtar and Dushanbe markets ranging from 2–8 percent and it decreased in Gharm by 2 percent. Beef price decreased in most monitored markets by the range of 0.3–2 percent.

# **Petrol & Diesel**

Prices for petrol and diesel in **Dushanbe** and **Bokhtar** markets **increased in the range of 1-1.4 percent** compared to previous week. While in **Khujand, Murghab and Gharm** markets, prices **decreased** in the range of **3-6.3 percent** for both commodities. **Bokhtar** market reported a price **decrease** for petrol by **14.3 percent.** 

Compared to the May 2020 monthly averages, prices decreased in most monitored markets for both commodities by a range of 3-11 percent. Meanwhile, Bokhtar market prices increased for both commodities ranging from 0.4–10 percent and Murghab market price for diesel increased by 10 percent.


